Lutheran-Catholic Joint Worship Service: Sunday, November 14 at 2:30 PM, Christ Lutheran Church, 815 Inkster Boulevard at Sinclair, with the theme, "Justified – freed for life." The joint service commemorates the fifth anniversary of the signing of the Joint Declaration on the Doctrine of Justification, which lifted mutual condemnations originating with the Protestant Reformation, and looks forward to the full healing of divisions within the universal Church of Christ. You are invited to join with the Lutheran community (Manitoba/ Northwestern Ontario Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada) and the Catholic community (Archdiocese of Winnipeg, Archdiocese of Saint-Boniface and Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg). Upon the invitation of His Grace, Metropolitan Michael, **His Beatitude Lubomyr**, together with the members of the Permanent Synod of the Bishops of the Ukrainian Catholic Church, will **visit Winnipeg May 2005**. During the visit, the entire hierarchy and clergy of the Winnipeg Metropolia will assemble May 24-26 in Winnipeg for a unique conference to reflect on the vocation and mission of the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada. The last time the clergy gathered from coast to coast for an assembly was 1962. Representatives from each of the five eparchies in Canada will meet in December in Winnipeg to plan the event.

- **Rev. John Martin Balagus** fell asleep in the Lord on October 24, 2004 in Sudbury at the age of 75. At the time of his passing, he was assistant pastor in Saint Mary Parish, Sudbury, and resident pastor at Saint Michael Parish, Coniston, ON. Eternal memory!
