They allow the director flexibility to focus on administrative and management tasks as needed.</li> <li>-The assistant directors' approach, recommendations, and energy shape the daily reality of camp life. This is a dynamic leadership opportunity for young adults who have grown beyond being a counselor.</li> </ul>

Their focus will be on creating a sense of belonging and helping campers participate fully in all daily activities including prayer, sports, arts, catechism, campfire, rest, transitions, etc. -Counselors are responsible for the safety and well being of the campers acting as a caregiver to the children while they are at camp. -Counselors will act as mentors to the Counselors in Training when present.

Maintain daily log, medical station cleanliness, storage of medication, inventory and distribution of supplies.</li> <li>-Assist lifeguards in any waterfront emergencies.</li> <li>-As time allows, the health officer will assist with programming and supervision, enhancing the mental health and wellbeing of staff, volunteers, and campers.</li> </ul>
